

# 1. OUT OF BOUNDS Rule 18-2

a) Beyond any fence, hedge or line of white markers

The hedge on the left of the 9th fairway and all ground to the left of the white stakes leading from that hedge up to the 9th green

c) The hotel drive and the practice area including that on the right hand side of the lake on the 18th hole

#### 2 OVERHEAD CABLES Rule 14.6

If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line (or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line) during the play of holes 13, 14 or 16, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.

#### 3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS Rule 16

All bridges, permanent paths, sprinkler valve covers, popup sprinklers and drain covers, bell posts,signs, ball cleaner posts and temporary metal teeing platforms are immovable obstructions. Relief from interference by an immovable (not a fazard) the player.
